

SUMMARY REPORT 16<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT  
 VA&R /Veteran Service Officers

1. The 16<sup>th</sup> District Service Officers are being actively recruited in support of the mission of providing “Veterans Service” to veterans and their dependants;
2. We are working on a consolidated approach to actively working with veterans and dependents in need;
3. This will be by directing and allocating those who seek assistance with Service Officers available rather than by geographic locality;
4. At least eight Service Officers were authorized to attend remotely the American Legion Service Officer National Training sponsored by AL Natl and conducted in both March and April of 2021 and in August of 2020;
5. We will shortly begin additional monthly administrative training so that all 16<sup>th</sup> District VSO’s administratively process the VA Claim’s in the same manner and methods as best to assist our veteran clients.
